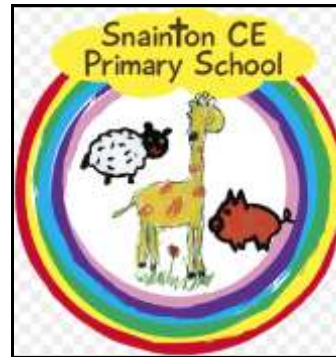


WELCOME
